16	Between 1852-1854 or between 56-59?	JHL Botefuhr ship wrecked off African coast and life spared by natives who had never seen a white man and believed him to be a new god. Forced to become member trobe, took a wife- blackened his body with berry juice-to disguise himself as a native-boarded a vessel and when at sea made himself known.
17	2/28/1854	born John Jacob Botefuhr (letter as 1858)
18	7/10/1854	died John Jacob Botefuhr--buried Greenwood Cemetery (son JHL Botefuhr)
19	12/22/1854	Volusia County, Florida created out of Orange
20	12/19/1856	born daughter Henrietta Botefuhr
21	1858	Botefuhr in Swatow, China ??
22	6/1/1860 CENSUS	JHL Botefuhr still living in Hoboken living with wife, and daughters Sarah, Mary C, and Henrietta (on same page is Kellett family and Charles Bernard)

24	1/1861	Georgia & Florida Seceded from US
25	4/1861	Civil War Declared- Firing on Fort Sumter
26	9/24/1864	born in Swatow, China Mercy Gilman Botefuhr
27	4/1865	CIVIL WAR ENDED
28	3/2/1867	The American bark Rover cleared at Swatow, China, in ballast for Newhwang on 2 March 1867 and sailed a few days after.
29	3/9/1867	The American bark Rover left Swatow
30	3/13/1867	The American barque Rover was wrecked on Vele Rete Rocks, southern Formosa; the crew was murdered, with the exception of one Chinese crew member. Including sister-in-law Mercy Botefuhr Hunt of JHL Botefuhr
31	5/29/1867	Swatow, China Botefuhr meets with Admiral Sir Henry Keppel During the afternoon of the Wednesday an old American acquaintance of former years at Whampoa, Mr. Botefuhr, came on board to solicit interference and assistance from me, which he stated he had in vain applied for to his own Admiral. Botefuhrs wife is sister to the wife fo the captain of the Rover, and although it is known that many were killed there is yet no positive proof that the captain and his wife were slain. My poor friend clung to the hope that the savages would not have the hear to murder one so fair as his sister-in-law, who was so young, and, as he described hwe, "only a few months married, comely to look on, and of nice proportions." It is difficult for me to interfer without causing jealousy on the part of the United States Admiral. Mr, friend, Botefuhr, has already drawn comparisons not complimentary to his countryman.
32	11/12/1867	Botefuhr in Amoy(China) at Consulate, testifies remains of his sister in-law Mercy G. (Bearnom) Hunt (Amoy is now known as Xiamen in Fujian Province)
33	7/5/1869	Botefuhr sails into New York and brings family back to New York on ship Samuel Russell
34	1869	JHL headed to Florida with Lord Tallyrand and Lord Webster , searched Florida coast-found spot on Halifax River. They visited with Doughlass Dummett at his grove on Merritt's Island and they took a shipment of oranges from there to Europe

35		JHL Botefuhr purchased Lot2, Sec 16, Tp 15 e. Range 33 E. (74 acres) fronted on the Halifax River across from Bethune Point, and was bordered by the ocean on the west. Today Botefuhr Avenue cuts the tract in half.
36	7/15/1870 CENSUS	JHL Botefuhr and family still living in Hoboken, New Jersey with wife and daughters Sarah, Henrietta & Mercy (Neighbors are father-in-law John Beerman and Lucy)also-Charles Barnard & Mary
37	1870??	JHL Botefuhr returns in a schooner loaded with lumber, from a torn down hotel.
38	1870	32x32 home built - 2 stories, double verandas front and back-the kitchen was separate in back. The Bostrom brothers helped build the home. It was never painted.
39	1871	Tax rolls show valuation of lot 2, the Botefuhr property was \$400.00
40	1871	Family comes from New York by Schooner-brought 6 months supply of food, horses, a dog, a cat, a few monkeys and several birds. Also hay & grain for stock. Schooner could not get past Live Oak Point.
41	1871	Swift Brothers rent their lighter to JHL Botefuhr to bring possessions up river, Botefuhr paid them \$40.00 per day for two days. (\$1,453.00 in 2016 dollars)
42	1871	Lot 3 to South of Botefuhr (69 acres) purchased by JHL Botefuhr's brother in law-Charles Barnard (home eventually at 2032 S. Peninsula Drive (The 600 feet on the river was fronted by a white stone wall)
43	6/6/1873	Henrietta Botefuhr, age 17 sails on Clara Merick to live with her Uncle and Aunt Mary Beerman Bernard in Brookly, New York. (actually Hoboken, New Jersey)
44	6/7/1873	JHL Botefuhr getting boat ready to take Mr. Markus over to Daytona
45	6/8/1873	Women are alone in household-get vist from Rev J. Smith, Charles Jackson, W. Jackson, Mr. Allen, Mr. Noble and Mrs. Johnson -visted for about 1 hour
46	6/9/1873	Botefuhr women only get two meals a day when JHL is away. JHL gets back home
47	6/10/1873	JHL in bad humor-bought potatoes and 40 turtle eggs-Sarah finishes sewing and receives 2.00 in payment-discusses the fact that Mr. Brown replaced \$5.00 that Henrietta had given her father that was to pay her way to New York
